The Idea

Tiny Pint is a two person, owner operated taproom and beer shop built to run lean.

We do one thing intentionally: serve **exceptional, curated beer** in **10–12 oz “Tiny Pints.”**

Why It Works

- **Right-sized:** 10 oz pour = ~40 % less beer per glass ~198 ‘Tiny Pints’ per keg instead of 124 full pints.
- **Low overhead:** No kitchen, no payroll, minimal utilities; just two bartenders who know what sells.
- **High touch:** Every guest gets a real conversation; every pour feels personal.
- **Smarter margins:** Lower cost per round + faster turnover = consistent profit, consistent freshness.

The Space

Compact, intentional, and easy to run.

- **Size:** 400–1,000 sq ft
- **Setup:** 2–3 tap system · CO₂ · cold storage · bar seating · warm lighting
- **Location:** Spokane or nearby corridor with walkup traffic, patio potential, parking

*A small footprint keeps rent and utilities low;
When the bills stay small, every pour hits harder.*

Two Spokane bartenders who've poured beer in breweries, taprooms, on busy service nights, and quiet day shifts. We know what sells, what sits, and how to make a small space feel good.
